This memorial scholarship has established for a student residing in the Marengo Union area pursuing a career in **the business or finance field**.

Amount of Scholarship: One (1) \$2,500 will be awarded.

Criteria:

- Will be awarded to a student going into the business or finance field.
- A minimum of a B (3.0) cumulative grade point average after 7 semesters.
- Attending post-secondary education at a two year or four year college.
- Write an essay on the topic of “What are your career goals, and how will this scholarship help contribute to your long-term career goals in the finance or business field?”
- Two (2) letters of recommendation from a teacher/counselor/employer/mentor.
