



The Marengo Park District is a municipal government agency established for the purpose of providing recreational parks, facilities, and programs for the community. The boundaries of the park district are the same as the City of Marengo.

The Park District has four parks, the largest of which is **Indian Oaks Park** (located on the southwest side of Marengo) with 75 acres including 5 shelters, 4 softball fields (1 lighted), par course, sand volleyball and numerous soccer fields, in addition to a disc golf course and hiking trail.

There are three neighborhood parks – Renwick, Brookside Meadows and Ridge Park.

Indian Oaks Park has a fitness center which is open 24/7 with key fob access 365 days of the year. It features treadmills, stair masters, recumbent bikes, ellipticals, and other aerobic equipment as well as a full free weight area with numerous machines and dumbbells. We have also have saunas, lockers and showers. Sauna memberships and personal locker rental is \$10/month or \$100/year.

Monthly Membership Fees- College Students and Seniors- \$20/ month; Single- \$30/month; Non-Residents pay \$5 more/month. Daily Drop-in fee is \$5. NO initiation or equipment fee. Pause or cancel at any time.

CALVIN SPENCER PARK

Calvin Spencer Park is a picturesque park boasting a Veteran's War Memorial, Purple Heart Memorial, memorials given in memory of loved ones and donations made in someone's name. There is a gazebo, brick walkways, manicured lawn and flower beds, picnic tables and charcoal grills.

The park is a city block, bounded by Van Buren Street on the north, Jackson Street on the south, Taylor Street on the east and Hale Street on the west. The land was donated in 1855, by Calvin Spencer, the first settler of Marengo. One distinction for the City of Marengo is that it has the only park named after a first male settler, Calvin Spencer.

The Village of Union is home to two wonderful parks.

Veterans Park, nestled between Main Street, Park Street and O'Cock Road, provides a convenient location for the Union Fireman's Carnival and other annual events.

Siems Memorial Park is a gem of a park on Highbridge Road, just east of the Village limits. Donated to the public by the Siems family, the park features picnic shelters, tables and beautiful vistas in all directions. For more information contact Wanda at 815-545-4266.

Eight elected aldermen in four wards and the Mayor comprise the City Council. The City Clerk is also an elected position. The City Treasurer is appointed by the Mayor, as are the City Administrator, Chief of Police, Building Commissioner and City Attorney. Appointments are subject to City Council approval. Elected officials serve four-year terms. Aldermen serve staggered terms. Municipal elections are held in April of odd-numbered years.

City Council meetings are held the second and fourth Monday of each month at 7 p.m. at City Hall. All City Council and committee meetings are open to the public. Meeting minutes and other public records are available from the City Clerk, [815] 568-7112.

The City of Marengo was incorporated in September of 1893, although the town officially commemorates its founding from 1835 - the year in which the area was first settled by Calvin Spencer.





The Marengo Fire and Rescue Districts, although two separate taxing districts, through cooperative efforts jointly provide Fire and EMS services to our citizens. Over the past several years the two districts have worked together to increase staffing, training, benefits for full time employees, and joint purchasing of equipment in order to provide the highest quality of service.

Marengo Fire and Rescue Districts staff 8 personnel a day providing 24-hour coverage 7 days a week. Staffing consists of 1 Battalion Chief (Shift Commander), 1 Captain, 1 Lieutenant, and 5 Firefighter/Paramedics. Personnel are split up between 3 stations located in Marengo and Union. Along with the full-time personnel, the districts employ several part time employees who assist in filling open shifts and additional responders during major events. The Chief of the districts as well as the two Assistant Chief's make up the command staff of the departments.

Our fleet consists of 3 ALS Ambulances (Staffed), 1 ALS Engine (Staffed), 1 BLS Engine (Staffed), 3 pumper/tankers, 1 heavy rescue, 2 brush trucks, and 3 staff vehicles.

Marengo Fire and Rescue Districts are committed to serving all within our districts while continuing to be fiscally responsible with revenues provided. Life Safety, Fire Prevention, and Property Conservation are the core values of our districts. We will continue to strive to meet those values at the highest levels. We appreciate the support provided by the citizens we serve, and graciously thank all who have made generous donations and memorials throughout the year.

The Union Fire Protection District (UFPD) provides services to the Village of Union and the surrounding rural community with currently 23 volunteer/paid on call firefighters. UFPD, founded in 1937, covers approximately 20 square miles and became a fire district in 1958. To inquire about becoming a firefighter or to learn more about the Union Fire Protection District please contact us at info@UFPD.org, www.ufpd.org or visit our Facebook page.

Emergency calls to 911 from Union area are dispatched through the City of McHenry, dispatch center. UFPD members are then alerted through a pager and/or smart phone app. The UFPD members respond from their home or work as the fire station on Main Street in Union is not manned. Additionally, Union Fire Dept has established an Auto Aid response from neighboring Marengo for responses as the Union population does not allow for funds to maintain a 24/7 in house staffed station.

UFPD has worked diligently over the years to maintain a modernized fleet of fire apparatus, which we provide auto and mutual aid to neighboring fire departments and their respective communities. Union provides service with the current fleet of Tenders, Fire Engines, Grass Rigs, UTV and command vehicles.



The majority of our average 150 annual calls are requests for Water Tenders - as much of the area does not have hydrants. Other types of calls are medical assistance, car accidents, grass fires, structure fires and alarms. Union firefighters train on a regular basis and many of our members have advanced firefighting training and are certified by the State of Illinois. Several firefighters have chosen to take advanced fire classes and others have become cross trained in emergency medical care – providing critical resources to our community. This includes training as EMT and Paramedics to assist Marengo Rescue, providing lifesaving services to our residents.

The UFPD members are very involved with our community – we assist with local charities, host pancake breakfasts for the local Lions Club and do annual fund raisers to raise money for scholarships and necessary tools for our firefighters. We hope you can join us for an upcoming event. Please follow Union Fire Protection District on Facebook for up to date information.


McHenry County Conservation District manages over 25,800 acres of open space graced with woodlands, prairies, wetlands, and savannas. Thirty-five sites are open to the public featuring 106 miles of hiking trails, 45 miles of biking trails, 25 fishing areas, 6 campgrounds, 6 canoe launches, 36 miles of horse trails, and 18 sites with picnic areas & shelters, and a multitude of opportunities for wildlife viewing. The District also boasts 17 dedicated State Nature Preserves within its sites. and hundreds of opportunities to attend outdoor environmental educational programs and events.

Three District sites are located in the Marengo-Union area:

Coral Woods - 7400 Somerset, Marengo: Best known for its sugar maple forest, this 808-acre conservation area hosts the District's annual Festival of the Sugar Maples event each March. Spring wildflowers and striking fall colors make this a favorite spot for hikers along the three miles of looped nature trails.

Marengo Ridge - 2411 N IL Route 23, Marengo: This 818-acre site boasts acres of oak and hickory woodlands. The tent and RV sites located in Thomas Woods Campgrounds make this a popular site. Hikers and cross-country skiers can also explore the over seven and a half miles of trails that wind through the site.

H.U.M. Trail - This 3.5 mile trail currently runs from East St. in Marengo to Vine St. in Union, connecting the two communities and perfect for hikers and cyclists. The trail head is one block NE of Rt. 20 on Prospect St. behind Marengo Middle School.

Building Permits: The City of Marengo has adopted codes and ordinances to protect the safety and well being of the structures in which we inhabit and properties we use. Most projects require an approved building permit to be issued prior to any construction. Typical permitting processes involve plans and specifications of your project to be submitted for review. The permit applications have the required information that is needed to be submitted. This review time allows staff to review and make notations for code compliance during the course

Bag & Tag Your Yard Waste: Leaves, grass clippings, garden waste, root balls, potted plants, dead plants, small sticks and twigs are considered yard waste. All yard waste should be put in bags and tagged for Marengo Disposal to pick up on your regular trash day. 32 gallon trash cans may also be used to contain your waste. Cans must be tagged for yard waste pick-up to be emptied. Yard waste will not be removed if it is left on the curbside not bagged and tagged, or if it is not in tagged 32 gallon cans. Tags may be purchased from: Marengo Disposal and Sullivans. If you have any questions regarding bagging and tagging yard waste, contact Marengo Disposal at 815-568-7274.

Burning: Burning of leaves, yard refuse or any other material is prohibited within the city limits. Recreational bonfires allowed with a permit only from the Police Department.

Leaf & Brush Pick-Up: Leaves must be put in the right of way, not the road. All brush must be placed in the right of way parallel to the road. City crews will do leaves and brush pick-up.

Calvin Spencer Park: This city park is available for use for weddings, reunions, picnics etc. The rules and regulations are available at City Hall. There is a \$200.00 refundable deposit that is required at the time you place your reservation. The park is available on a first come, first served basis.

Tornado Siren: The tornado siren is tested at approximately 10 a.m. on the 1st Tuesday of every month. In an emergency, when the siren is sounded, seek shelter and tune your radio to a local station [105.5 FM or 1600 AM] for more information.

Commuter Train Service: Metra's Northwest line offers commuter rail service between downtown Chicago and Harvard on a daily basis. Harvard Station Phone: [815] 943-5244. Call Metra at [312] 322-6777 for schedules and information, or visit www. metrarail.com.

Raffle Licenses: If your non-for-profit organization wishes to hold a raffle of any kind in Marengo, there is a form that is available at City Hall that must be completed. The City Administrator approves raffles. These tickets may only be sold inside the city limits of Marengo. If you sell tickets in the unincorporated area of Marengo, you must contact McHenry County, as they also require the information.

Business license: Beginning May 1st, 2025 all businesses must have a City of Marengo business license.

Snow Removal Procedure: The City of Marengo reminds residents that in the event of two or more inches of snow accumulation, parking on any City street is not permitted until the streets are cleared. This is enforced to assist with prompt snow removal. Also, homeowners are reminded, that for safety reasons and to accommodate walkers, snow is to be removed from sidewalks within 24 hours after the end of a snow event.

Solicitor Permits: Solicitor permits are required in residential neighborhoods. Apply for a permit at the Police Department.

Drop-Off Box: For your convenience, the City of Marengo now has two 24 hour drop-off boxes located at the City Hall office main entrance at 132 E. Prairie Street, as well as the entrance off of the municipal parking lot.

Street Parking: Unless otherwise posted, two-hour parking shall be permitted in the Central Business District. Parking is not allowed on residential streets between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. Parking is not allowed on any street in the business district between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. Parking is not allowed on ANY STREET in the event of an ice storm, or when 2 inches or more of snow has fallen.

Garage Sales: City residents are allowed to hold two garage sales per year. A permit is required for each garage sale at a cost of \$5.00. Permits can be obtained at the City Hall or downloaded on the city website. Please note that garage sale signs cannot be posted on any public property including the parkway, light poles or parkway trees. Signs advertising such sales are limited to three in number, they should only be displayed during the dates of licensed sale and should be removed within 24 hours of the end of the sale. Signs must have their own support or post to be affixed in the ground. Signs are not allowed to be attached to telephone poles, trees, stop and go lights or any City, State or Federal signage.

Driver's License Facility: The closest driver's license and testing facility is located at 428 S. Eastwood Dr. [Rt. 47] Woodstock, IL 60098. Call [312] 793-1010 for information.

State Vehicle License Plate Stickers: Available at Banks, required info: Make, model, year, serial#, plate#.

Notary Public: Documents can be notarized at City Hall, at the Chamber of Commerce office or at any number of local banks and insurance companies. The City offers Notary services to City residents at no fee. You will need a picture I.D., and must sign the document(s) in the City office, in the presence of the Notary.

ABSENTEE VOTER'S BALLOT

Any qualified voter who will be out of the county on election day may – by making application to the County Clerk not more than forty and not less than five days prior to the election – receive an affidavit, and when properly filled out and returned to the County Clerk, said qualified voter will be mailed a ballot with instructions on how to vote. Any voter who is going to be out of the county on election day may apply in person at the County Clerk's office for a ballot through the day prior to the election.

PERMANENTLY DISABLED VOTER'S CARD

A permanently disabled person may apply to the County Clerks Office for an application for a Disabled Voter's Identification Card, which will expire five years from date of issuance. Such card will permit the voter to vote an absentee ballot for each election. For further information, please contact the County Clerk's Office.
